In January 2017, Ipswitch commissioned a follow-up survey to the 2015 poll of IT pros in the UK, France and Germany. The survey asked about the implications of the impending GDPR changes and preparations undertaken by these organizations.



UK RESULTS



IN 2017:
1 in 3 businesses
report not knowing
how the GDPR will apply to them.

GROWING UNCERTAINTY

IN 2017:
48% say investment
in new technologies
will be required to be compliant.

ABOUT THE IMPACTS

But compared to 2015
2x the number
are 'unsure'.



IN 2017:
37% say it is a burden

OF THE GDPR

But compared to 2015
5x the number
are 'unsure'.

BREXIT EFFECT? Since the 2015 survey, a distinct increase in 'unsure' responses may reflect the overall uncertainty around the Brexit decision.
